3:00 pm	Anticipated finish time for NLDR in front of NBYC pier.	Allow 60 minutes after lead boat finish for DNFs (may be extended by committee discretion)
4:00 pm	Lodge protests by this time	Socializing time. There has never been a National Cruise (Long Distance) Race protest that we can remember.
6:00 pm	Dinner (type to be determined) at the club. <b>Please advise numbers in advance</b> to help ensure we have enough food.	<b>\$22pp paid at registration. Clubhouse bar open.</b>

Onshore lunch after 2 <sup>nd</sup> race (or as otherwise directed by the RC). On shore lunch paid with registration. Additional persons \$8 each.

10:45 am assuming wind is “up”	Start of “ <b>Poker Event</b> ” – this is a fun event. Speed is not essential to success as good Poker hands are extremely beneficial. Come and have fun with other Wayfarer sailors.	Sail to waypoints on Trout Lake (map will be provided), obtain cards at each location, then proceed to the finish. Note: this event is NOT conducted under the normal RRS. Other rules and exceptions may apply, so stay sharp!
1:00 pm	BBQ Shore Lunch at McNutt’s cottage. Family members also welcome. <b>Please advise numbers in advance to help ensure we have enough food. Lunch included in race registration for 2 people per boat. \$8 each additional person.</b>	Fred and Anne McNutt hosting. Scoring based on arrival position (1/3) and strength of poker hands (2/3). Sort your cards to make your two strongest hands. Boats carrying a 3 <sup>rd</sup> person get a 15% scoring advantage.
3:30 pm	Sail back up Trout Lake to starting point at Armstrong Beach.	Normally, a very pleasant sail on a south west breeze.
