2017 Wayfarer Canadian National Championship Series (Saturday/Sunday 8/9 July 2017)

North Bay Yacht Club, Callander, Ontario

- **Rules** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020. Racing rule changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions which will be issued prior to the first Skipper's Meeting.
- **Entry Fee** **Early registration (received prior to or by 21 June)** - \$95 which includes banquet dinner for skipper and crew (additional persons for banquet dinner \$25 each).

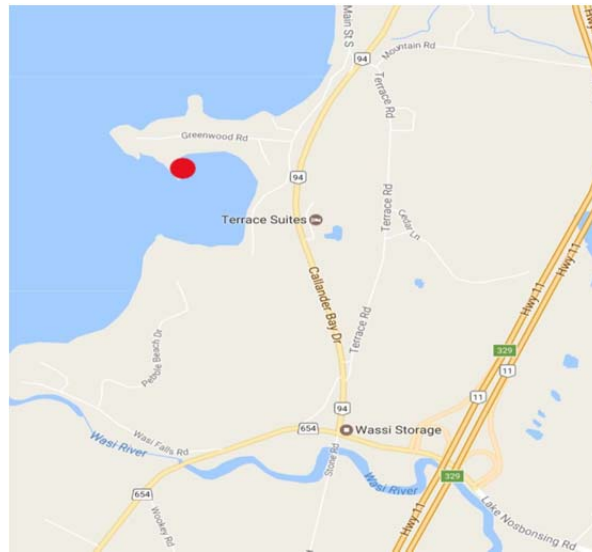
Registration (received after 21 June) - \$105 which includes banquet dinner for skipper and crew (additional persons for banquet dinner \$25 each).

Note: Advance payment can be made by cheque payable to Carol Hansman. Payment at event cash only please. Please refer to "**Entry Form 2017**" for additional information.
- **Schedule** Up to 5 races are scheduled for Saturday 8 July, no races to start after 3:30 pm
Up to 4 races are scheduled for Sunday 9 July, no races to start after 2:30 pm
Refer to "**Schedule of Events**" for details.
- **Scoring** One race completed will constitute a series if no further races can be completed. When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- **Awards** Awards for 1st through 3rd, Most Improved, plus other awards at the Committee's discretion. Winner will receive the "*Smallcraft of Southampton Trophy*" for 2017, as our national champion. *The Don Rumble Memorial Series* trophy for 2017 will be awarded to the team with the best record on the 1st day of racing provided at least one race is completed on the 1st day.
- **Eligibility** Open to all boats of the Wayfarer class. Each participating skipper must be properly registered and a paid member of Canadian Wayfarer Association, the USWA or the UKWA. Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with a cheque for the required Entry Fee, to Carol Hansman by the dates shown on the form.
- **Insurance** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.
- **Disclaimer** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority, volunteers and/or the North Bay Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- **Directions** The North Bay Yacht Club is located on Callander Bay of Lake Nipissing, on the south side of the town of Callander, Ontario. Callander is the first town south of the City of North Bay along Highway #11. Access to Callander off Hwy #11 is either via Hwy #654 if coming from the south, or via Lakeshore Drive and Pinewood Park Drive if coming from the north, west or east.

From the south, the exit from Hwy #11 on to Hwy #654 is approximately 18 km south of North Bay (central). From the off-ramp, turn right on #654 heading west for about 0.5 km to reach Callander Bay Road (old Hwy #11). Turn right and proceed for approximately 1 km to the south entrance to Main Street, Callander which will be on your left. Turn left and then immediately left again onto

Green Road. After about 250 metres, at the Green Road Cottages, turn right onto Green Road and proceed 200 metres to the NBYC which will be on your left.

Coming from the north, west or east you will pass through and by North Bay, proceeding south on Hwy #11 as if going to Toronto. Once you leave the intersection of Hwy #11 and #17 (which comes from Ottawa), you can take either of the next two exits. If you miss the first one, proceed to the second exit which is Hwy #654 (instructions above). The first exit takes you to Lakeshore Drive. Turn left at the first signal lights on to Pinewood Park Drive and proceed along this road (old Hwy #11). Pinewood Park Drive will turn into Callander Bay Drive, so continue along and go past the north entrance to Main Street, Callander, and past two more intersections (Swale and Landsdowne Streets). When you see the lake you will be taking the next turn right which will be the south entrance to Main Street. Make a right and then an immediate left onto Green Road. Proceed as described above.
