

**NOTICE OF RACE**  
**Lake Eustis Sailing Club**  
**20th Wayfarer Midwinter Regatta**  
**February 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2019**

**ORGANIZING AUTHORITY:**

The United States Wayfarer Association ([www.uswayfarer.org](http://www.uswayfarer.org))

**HOST ORGANIZATION:**

Lake Eustis Sailing Club located at 1310 CR 452, Eustis, FL 32726. The Club is approximately 40 miles northwest of Orlando ([www.lescfl.com](http://www.lescfl.com))

(Note: this regatta coincides with an Melges MC regatta being held at the Club)

**ENTRIES and ELIGIBILITY:**

The Regatta is open to all Wayfarer and CL16 Class sailors.

There will be two separate classes, which will race together but be scored separately:

- **The Spinnaker Class** — which will conform to the rules of the Wayfarer Class with both skipper and crew required, and
- **The Non-Spinnaker Class** — which may be single- or double-handed, and in which the use of spinnakers is prohibited. Single-handed entries are not eligible for the Ian Proctor Trophy

**RULES:**

The race will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020, and the Wayfarer Class Rules.

Radio use:

- Signal flags and sound signals will be the sole means used by the Race Committee to communicate with the competitors.
- There shall be a designated Race Committee channel. Competitors may not monitor, nor have radio tuned to this channel.
- There shall be a designated competitors channel as a safety and emergency channel. Competitors may and are encouraged to carry a radio tuned to this channel. Competitors may transmit only to report safety or emergency matters, or to report that they are retiring.
- A cell phone may be carried, but may be used only for emergency purposes.
- The penalty for breaking this rule is disqualification from the regatta, or such lesser penalty as may be determined.

(Clarifies Rule 35.3 Wayfarer International Class Rules and LESC Rules).

### **REGISTRATION:**

Boat registration is \$80 if you notify us by January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019. Entries after that date are \$90. Registration is available online at [www.RegattaRegistration.com](http://www.RegattaRegistration.com). Boat registration includes breakfast on all three days and dinner on Saturday evening for both skipper and crew. Payment is to be made in US funds only (LESC can now accept credit cards for payment).

The honor system continues: If you let Dave or Pat know before January 1<sup>st</sup> that you are coming plus what your meal requirements will be you can pay \$80 (plus meals) when you get here. Include your name, boat number and email address in your pre-registration.

Lunches for skipper and crew for Friday and Saturday and for guests may be purchased at \$8 each, and guests may purchase Saturday dinner at \$15 if ordered before January 1<sup>st</sup> - after that date, additional lunches and dinners cannot be guaranteed.

**SCORING:**

The Low Point Scoring System will apply with one throw-out if four (4) or more races are sailed (changes RRS A2). One completed race will constitute a regatta.

**TROPHIES:**

Keeper trophies will be awarded for the top three finishers in each class. In addition, the Ian Proctor Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the top finisher.

**LODGING:**

Camping is allowed on the grounds of the Club (on the north side of building) with showers and toilets available in the Clubhouse. Please declare intent to camp at the regatta registration site, or in an email (patkuntz16@yahoo.com) – first come, first served!
