# Canadian Wayfarer Association Executive Committee Meeting

## Wednesday 5 April 2023, 8:00 pm Via Zoom

- 1. Approval of the agenda: standard agenda with the addition of a rule change proposed by the SWA, and discussion of condolences on the passing of longtime USWA member Jim Cook
  - moved by Mike, seconded by Dave; carried
- 2. Minutes of the meeting of 15 February 2023 (circulated after the last meeting)
  - approval: moved by Scott, seconded by Al; carried

#### 3. Finances

- Mike reported that the eTransfer system is working well for receiving payments
- there is an outstanding balance owing to Kit for mailing calendars, and another amout owed to Rob for trophy engraving
- The current bank balance is \$11591.33

## 4. Membership

- Kit reported that only two more members have paid since the last report;
- there are currently 34 paid members out of a total of 50 (including 13 honorary members and 3 advertisers)
  - Action: Kit will send out a reminder to people about renewing for the year, and include a note about the date of the AGM;
- There was some discussion of who would be responsible for roles that had been covered by Steph before he stepped aside for the year;
  - Al offered to temporarily assume the advertising and WIC treasurer roles;
  - Steph will connect with Al in early May to brief him on things that need to be done;

#### 5. Events Calendar

- Al has reached out to John O'Dwyer for confirmation on hosting the Candadians at MCC in August
- Rob received word from Marc Bennett indicating there was some doubt about the status of the Wayfarer North Americans at Tawas Bay in Sept;
  - Action: Al will connect with Marc to sort out the details.
- TS&CC is interested in hosting an event on the 8-9 July weekend if there is interest
  - Action: Kit will connect with Nick at TS&CC, and once some details have been worked out Al will post it to the calendar;

### 6. AGM Planning

- Since the last meeting the opportunity to host the AGM at MCC fell through;
- The fall back date is Friday 23 June at Conestoga SC, on the eve of the Warm Water Regatta;
- Effort will be made to offer a virtual attendance option;

#### 7. Class Rules

- the SWA has sent out a proposal to amend the following rules
  - 5.3 to prohibit a measurer from measuring a boat they have an interest in, permitting "in house" certification for the Copyright Holder;
  - 5.4 remove the requirement for the builder to sign measurement certificates; under the proposal only the measurer and owner would be required to sign the measurement certificate;
  - Under the CWA constitution the Executive needs to decide whether the proposed change is of sufficient importance to take it to the class membership for approval;
    - following discussion it was determined that it would be expedient to have the proposal approved by the executive;
      - Motion to take the rule change to the membership (moved by Scott, seconded by Mike); defeated
      - the committee will decide the proposal
  - Motion to approve the proposed rule changes (moved Dave, seconded Al): carried
    - Action: Al will communicate the decision to Poul Ammentorp, the International Secretary

#### 8. Jim Cook

- Rob requested input on the wording of a note of condolence he is preparing to send on behalf of the CWA for the upcoming memorial service for Jim Cook, USWA, who passed away recently;
- in the interest of getting the note written quickly, there was consensus in support of Rob composing the message;
- Kit has also circulated a note about Jim's passing to the membership with instructions for anyone who wishes to send their own personal condolences;
